Behavior

The art classroom maintains conversation level voices. It is expected that students will respect staff, materials and other students.

Restroom pass will be granted at the very beginning of class, providing the student is on time to class, or a few minutes before the end of class.

Exceptions are emergency only or medical conditions.

Due to the nature of the class, no food or beverage is permitted. (*This keeps artwork from becoming ruined and risk of illness to a minimum.*)

Tardies will not be tolerated.

1st Tardy - Verbal WARNING.

2-3rd Tardy - Detention

CLEANING art room and/or phone call home.

4th Tardy - - Referral to

Any behavior concerns will be addressed as follows:

Assessments

In-class summatives (artwork) **will not** be taken home to complete. Writing portions of assessments are expected to be completed at home if needed.

In-class assessments considered as long term projects have a due date. A **zero** will be recorded **UNTIL** he/she turns the work in completed. **Students have up to one week before the end of a grading period to finish work or redo/fix work.** They are encouraged to take advantage of before/after school help or during any free time.

It is student's responsibility to check for and make up missed work, due to absence or field trip.

Please review the ***District Policy on Retakes*** as it applies to this class as well.

Homework is RARELY given as such, however, reading/writing will be incorporated into the curriculum and is expected to be completed if necessary at home.

Grading will be done as stipulated in the District's Grading and Assessment Policy.(See Below)
