FOOTBALL:

Varsity * Age 10-13 165 LB max (Based on player's age on 6/01/18)

*Must be under 13 before August 1st and enrolled in sixth grade

Junior Varsity Age 8-10 145 LB max (Based on player's age on 6/01/18) Freshmen* Age 6-7 125 LB max (Based on player's age on 6/01/18)

*Must turn 6 by June 1st of upcoming season

Fees: 1st Child \$200; 2nd Child \$150 (*new family add \$25 to 1st child)

**11x11 tackle and 7x7 tackle options available for both Varsity and Junior Varsity levels.

Football fees include:

- All necessary equipment to play, practice jersey, game jersey (player gets to keep)
- Practice Field and equipment use
- Two free tickets to the end of the season banquet and awards
- Camp T-Shirt and end of season gift

CHEERLEADING:

Girls in 1st through 7th grade are permitted to cheer in the WYFC

Fees: 1st Child \$150.00; 2nd Child \$100.00 (*new family add \$25 to 1st child)

Cheerleading fees include:

- Practice Field and equipment use
- Two free tickets to the end of the season banquet and awards
- Camp T-Shirt and end of season gift
- Cheer Keepsake

NOTE: If you have a football player, the cheerleader sibling **ONLY** pays the additional child fee of \$100.00.

Football players and Cheerleaders must be residing within the Mayfield School district.

NEW WYFC FAMILIES have a onetime, non-recurring membership fee of \$25.00 (paid at time of registration).

REGISTRATION DEADLINE date is July 5th, 2019

Any registration received after July 5th will be put on a waiting list and will be subject to late fees.
