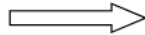


# CHINA

 (1 single party makes all economic and political decisions)  
 Type of Leader = **PRESIDENT**  
 Citizens' Rights (circle one) HIGH **LOW**

 1. **Can Vote - but only for one party**  
 2. **Can now have TWO children**  
 3. **Can choose own clothing**

**No freedom of speech or press**

Type of Economy: **MIXED MARKET**

One import is:

**Oil, vehicles**

**Manufactured goods**

(Things that are made - lots of electronics: computers, phones, etc.)

1 push factor:

**Low rights, low wages, overcrowding**

1 pull factor:

**Market is growing, wages are going up, education is improving**

**Overcrowding - space is limited**

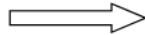
1 pull factor:

2. **MUST obey government**
3. **Limited voting**

1 thing citizens are allowed to do in this country:

**MUST serve at least 2 years in the military**

1 thing citizens cannot do in this country is:

**Cannot leave or speak out against the country. Punishments are very strict if you do!**

Type of Economy: **COMMAND (Communism)**

1 push factor:

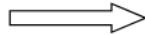
**Strict government, little rights, no freedoms**

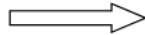
