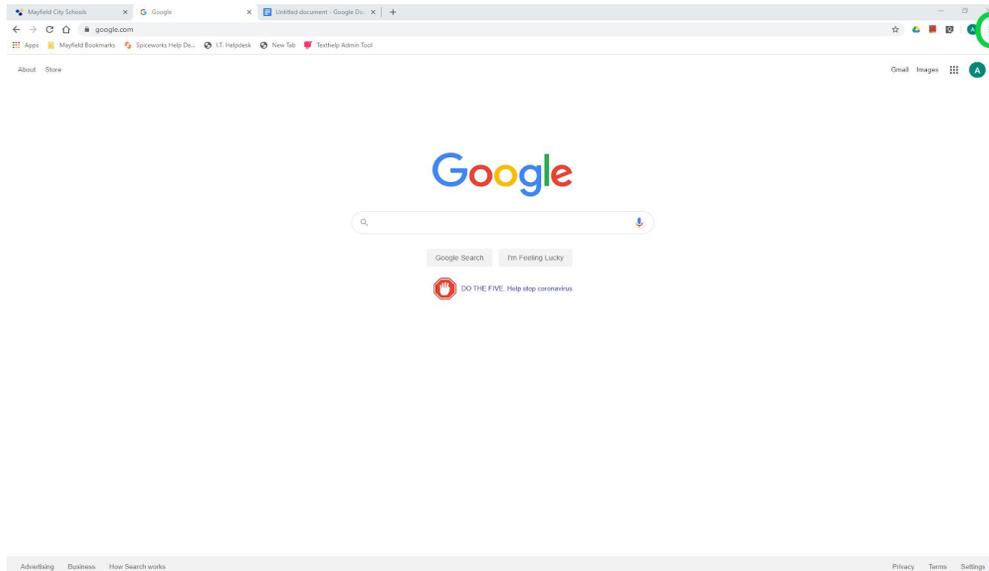


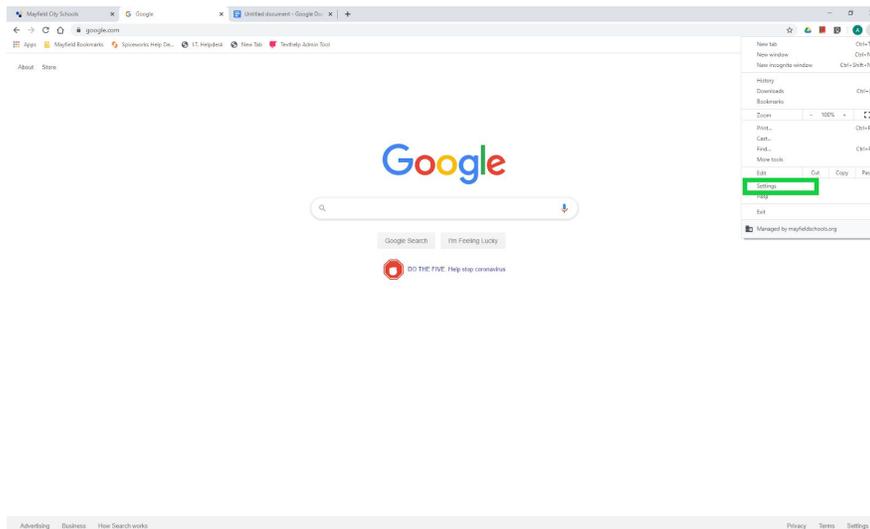
Chrome Camera and Microphone Settings

If you want to block a website from accessing your mic or camera, or if you want to allow a website to access them, you can do so under Chrome's settings menu.

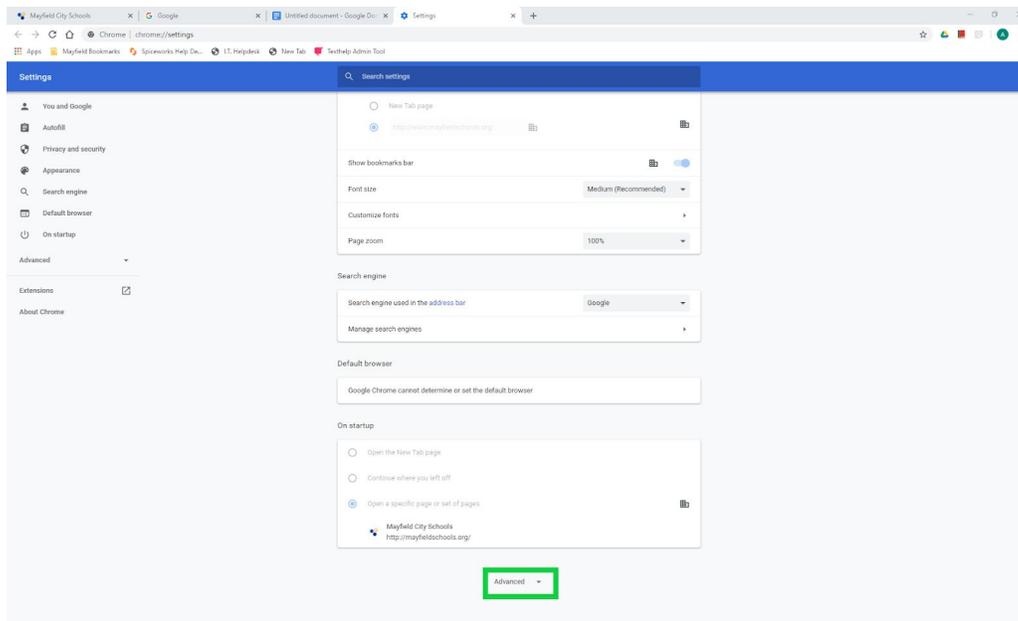
1. Open Chrome and select the **Chrome menu**, represented by three vertical dots in the top-right corner.



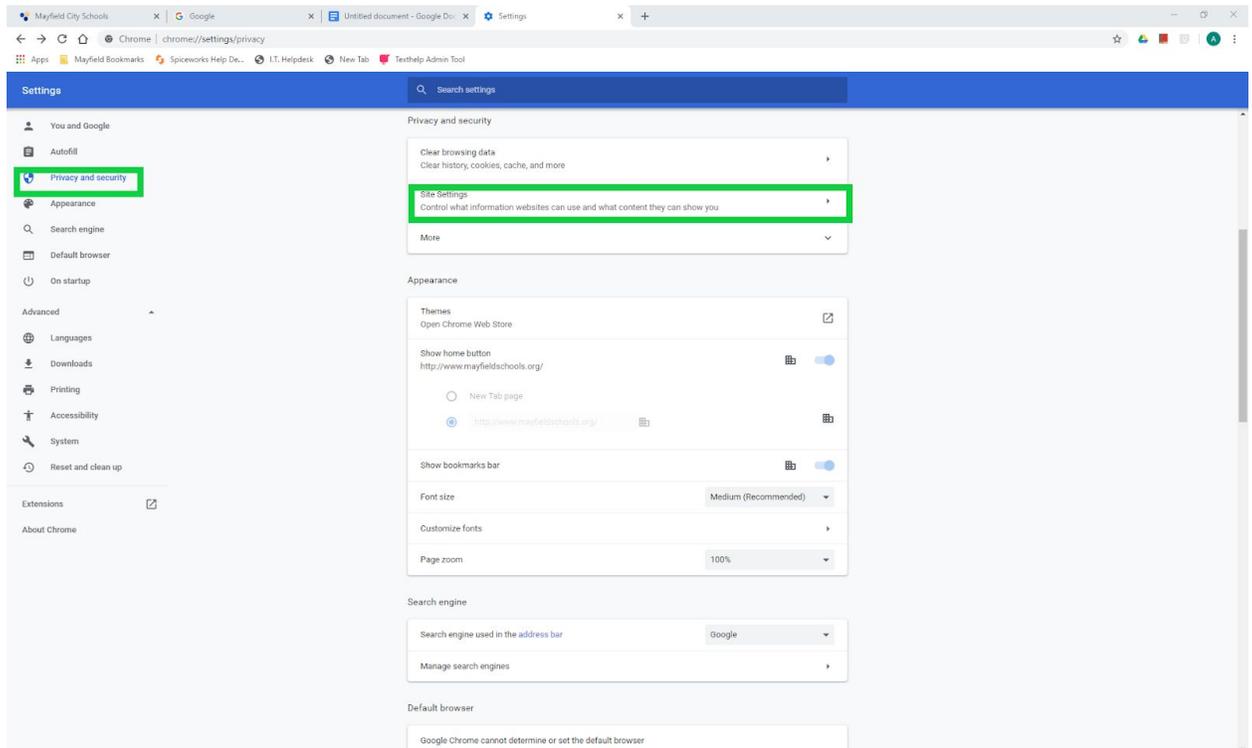
2. Select **Settings**.



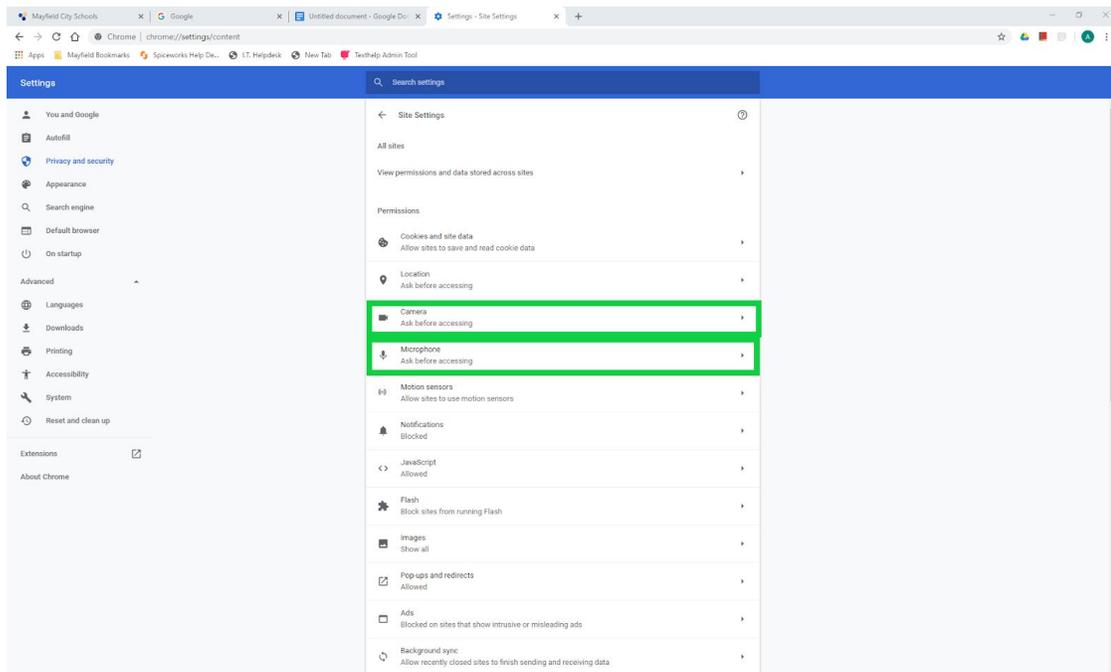
3. Scroll down and select **Advanced**.



4. Under the **Privacy and security** section, select **Site settings**.



5. Select either **Camera** or **Microphone** to access either setting.



6. You can manually change camera and microphone access for individual websites. Select the **arrow icon** next to the website, then scroll down to **Camera** or **Microphone**, and choose whether to **Allow** or **Block** that site's access to your device.
7. If you remove a website from the block list, it doesn't move it to the allow list and vice versa. Instead, deleting a website from Chrome's list of blocked sites lets you choose to **Allow** or **Block** permission the next time the site requests access to either your camera or mic. In contrast, if the site is on the list of blocked sites for the camera and you try to use your camera, you won't be asked to use it. It will be blocked automatically.
