Our Mission

The Free Clinic's mission is to address vital community health needs by providing high quality health care and related services to individuals and families, regardless of their ability to pay, and by advocating for policy changes that promote greater access for the underserved and improved community-wide health and wellness outcomes.

Our Facility

The Free Medical Clinic of Greater Cleveland was established as a hotline in 1970 by a small group of people concerned about the health and welfare of young adults, but it quickly transformed to a clinic serving the health needs of the community. Since its founding, The Free Clinic has grown from a small clinic based in a rented house to a community health center occupying a 34,000 square foot building with over 57 employees and 600 volunteers. The facility, located in University Circle, is equipped with 18 exam rooms, 5 dental chairs, 3 group therapy rooms, a modern laboratory, and an in-house pharmaceutical dispensary.

Adult Primary Care Clinic

Project DAWN ~ Deaths Avoided with Naloxone

- ◆ Tuesdays: Noon ~ 4pm Fridays: 1:00 ~ 5:00pm
- ♦ Walk-in; no appointment necessary
- A community-based drug overdose prevention and education project
- ◆ Participants receive training on recognizing overdose symptoms and administering medication (Naloxone) to reverse the effects of an opioid (heroin and some prescription pain pills) overdose
- Medication and kits provided to qualifying patients and individuals who know people at risk of opioid overdose.
