1. How did labor unions try to address workplace issues?

Labor unions worked to improve working conditions. A major goal was higher pay. Labor leaders also fought for workers' compensation for workers injured on the job.

2. What did the Supreme Court decide in *Muller v. Oregon* and *Lochner v. New York*? What reasons did the court give for its ruling?

Lochner v. New York

states cannot restrict rights of employers to enter any type of labor agreement (contract) they wished

Muller v. Oregon

upheld state laws limiting women's working hours court stated that a woman's health is matter of public concern

Muller v. Oregon was first case progressives won using arguments based on economic and social evidence.

POLITICAL REFORM VOCABULARY

direct primary - method of allowing voters to choose their own candidates for office

mayor - executive of a city

city commission - group of elected officials runs a city; each official manages a major city agency (housing, sanitation, transportation)

initiative - law enabling voters to propose a new law by collecting signatures on a petition

17th Amendment - allowed voters to directly vote for US Senators

city managers - appointed by city council; runs the city

Galveston, TX - after the hurricane in 1900, Galveston adopted the city commission form of city government

· emphasized efficiency and economy through the election of commissioners on city wide basis

referendum - measure allowing citizens to vote on proposed laws

Wisconsin Idea - Governor Robert La Follette's program of reforms for Wisconsin in the early 1900s; became a model for other state governments

- favored the direct primary, new state commissions, and tax reform
- reduce power of political machines

recall - measure allowing voters to remove an official from office before his or her term is over

city council - elected by voters; group of people that serves in an administrative capacity for a particular city; appoints a professional manager to run city
