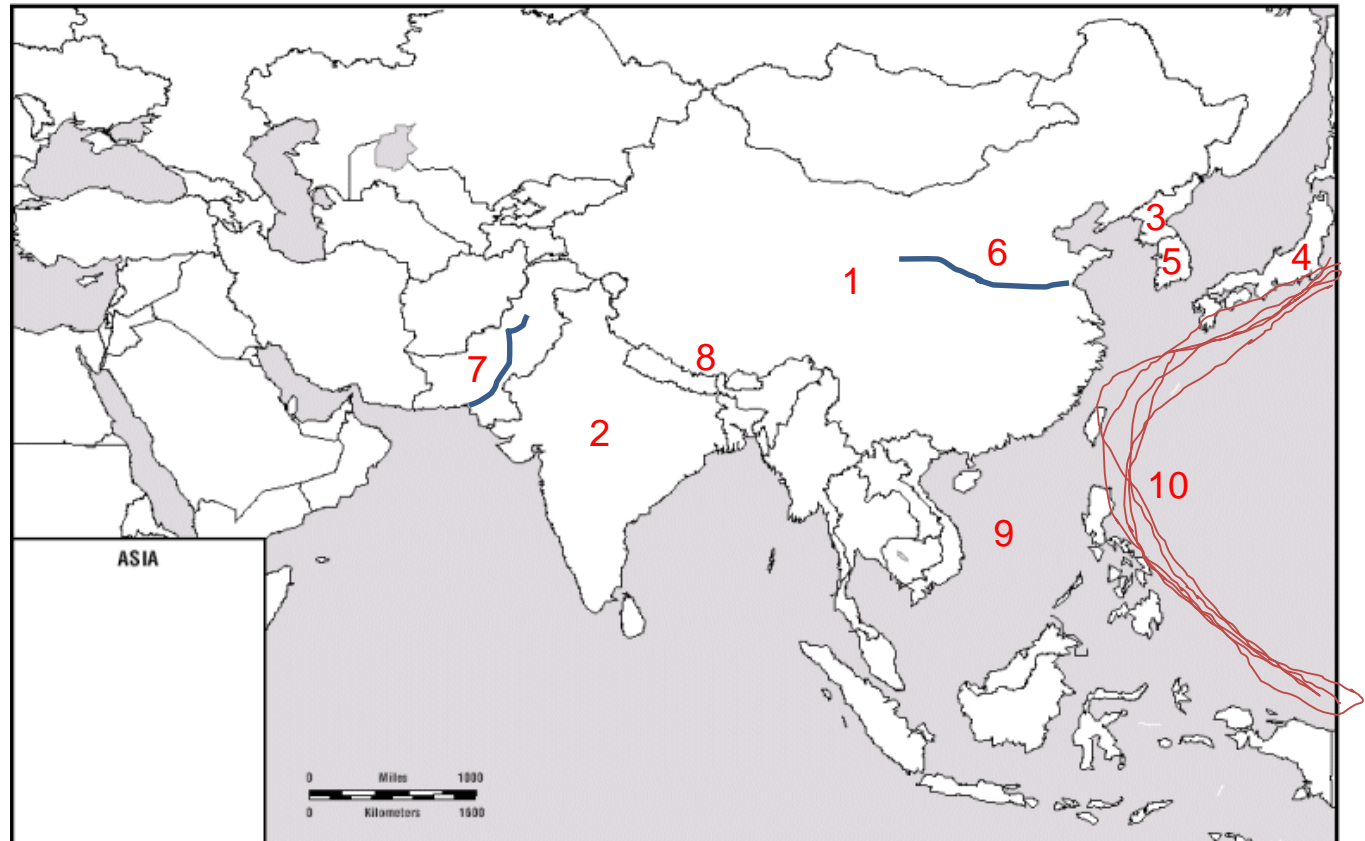

Who makes business decisions?	Citizens	Government	Government
