We are looking forward to welcoming your ninth grader to Mayfield High School for the 2019-2020 school year! The first day of school for students is **Thursday, August 15, 2019**.

Please save the following dates for the Wildcat Focus Camp. The two-day camp will take place on **Monday, August 5th, from 3:00 P.M. to 7:00 P.M. and Tuesday, August 6th, from 9:00 A.M. to 1:00 P.M.** Students should report to the auditorium to start each day. A wide range of fun activities have been planned to help better orient the incoming freshman class to daily life at Mayfield High School. Monday evening, we will be serving a pizza dinner for students only at 6:15 P.M. as part of the program.

On Monday, August 5th at 7:00 PM students will complete their day by joining their parents in the auditorium for a brief orientation program. We strongly encourage all parents to attend. Your child's schedule will become available via the Campus Student/Campus Parent Portal in July. The most updated schedule will be available during the Wildcat Focus Camp.
