Participation	
<b>3.0</b>	<b>The student is successful while engaged in classroom activities.</b>
<b>2.0</b>	<b>The student is showing progress with practice and support while engaged in classroom activities.</b>
<b>1.0</b>	<b>The student is experiencing difficulty and requires consistent practice and support while engaged in classroom activities.</b>
Participation means...	a. Attempting to answer direct questions asked by the teacher (for example, trying to answer a question when called on by the teacher)
	b. Waiting for an appropriate time to ask a question or make a comment (for example, waiting to ask a question, raising hand, and not speaking until called on by the teacher)
Work Completion	
<b>3.0</b>	<b>The student meets all required expectations regarding assignments and work completion.</b>
<b>2.0</b>	<b>The student is showing progress with practice and support while engaged in classroom activities.</b>
<b>1.0</b>	<b>The student is experiencing difficulty and requires consistent practice and support while engaged in classroom activities:</b>
Work Completion means...	a. Attempting to follow general directions for assignments (for example, following the teacher's directions, handing in papers, and writing name on paper)
	b. Producing quality work

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Behavior	
<b>3.0</b>	<b>The student follows all classroom rules and procedures.</b>
<b>2.0</b>	<b>The student is showing progress with practice and support while following classroom rules and procedures.</b>
<b>1.0</b>	<b>The student is experiencing difficulty and requires consistent practice and support while following classroom rules and procedures.</b>
Behavior means...	a. Respecting others (for example, keeping hands and feet to self, listening when others are talking)
	b. Respecting self ( for example, remaining on task, working independently)
	c. Respecting property (for example, using supplies appropriately, maintaining and organizing materials, following rules for work space, restrooms, playgrounds, etc. )

<b>3.0</b>	<b>The student is successfully using interpersonal skills while engaged in classroom activities.</b>
<b>2.0</b>	<b>The student is showing progress using interpersonal skills with practice and support while following classroom rules and procedures.</b>
<b>1.0</b>	<b>The student is experiencing difficulty using interpersonal skills and requires consistent practice and support while following classroom rules and procedures.</b>
Working in Groups means...	a. Taking turns in group activities
	b. Not interrupting others in the group when they are speaking
	c. Actively participating in group work
