

## Equal Access for all Students

---

Mayfield City School District assures equal access to screening and further assessment for all district students through provision of acceptable accommodations, administration in native language where applicable, and use of appropriate instruments valid for special populations by qualified individuals. The district accepts current outside testing data that is less than two years old and from an ODE approved identification instrument administered by a trained professional. Any student transferring into the district will be assessed within ninety days at the request of the parent. Referral forms are available through the Building Administrator, Gifted Intervention Specialist, or Gifted Coordinator. Any student who has requested assessment or who has been recommended by teachers, parents, or other students, will be provided with at least two opportunities a year for assessment in all grade levels K-12.

## Process for Appeal

---

If a parent is not in agreement with the screening procedure or assessment, the scheduling of students for assessment, the placement of a student, or the receipt of services, they may appeal the decision in writing within 30 days of the beginning of the service to the district superintendent. The superintendent will review the appeal and submit a decision to the parent within 15 days. The decision of the superintendent shall be final.

## Parent Notification of Results

---

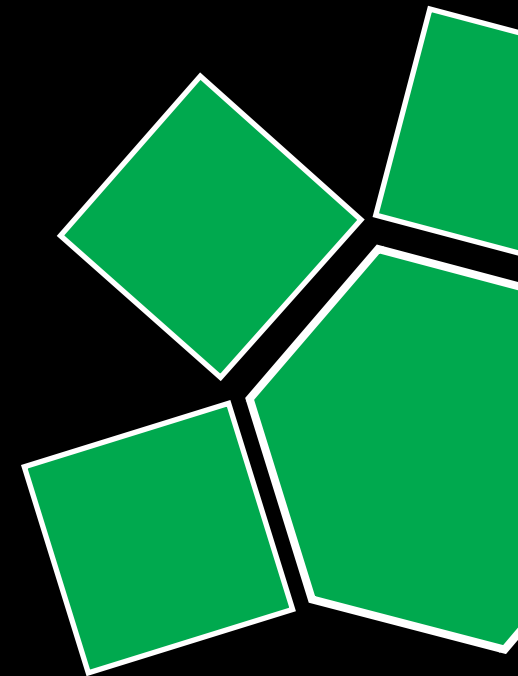
Parents will be notified in writing within 30 days of the receipt of the assessment results. Parent reports from District Wide Assessments are sent out following those assessments. Mayfield provides opportunities for reassessment of students who, upon screening for gifted identification, meet the district's designated screening score of 93% + for a follow up assessment.
