Dear Mayfield City Schools Teachers, Staff, Parents and Community,

As we enter the second full school year in a pandemic, Mayfield City School leaders continue to daily review COVID-19 data as it relates to our four communities - Mayfield Heights, Mayfield Village, Gates Mills and Highland Heights. Each day, district officials examine and discuss COVID-19 case data from local health experts and zip code case data (44124, 44143, 44040) to drive our decisions, along with case counts reported on the Mayfield City Schools COVID-19 dashboard and daily attendance across the district and at our schools.

We want to thank those of you who participated in the face mask survey which ended Saturday, August 14th at 11 p.m. The survey results are now being evaluated and analyzed by the company which developed the survey questions. We anticipate the survey data will be available soon and will be shared with the community once complete. The district continues to strongly recommend all students and staff wear face masks inside our school buildings.

As has been our past practice, the district will continue to notify parents, teachers and staff of positive COVID-19 cases as they are reported. Today, the district was notified of 2 positive COVID-19 cases involving 1 Mayfield High School student and 1 Mayfield Middle school staff member. In accordance with the established protocols set forth by the CCBH, the staff member and student will remain at home for 10 days and may return to school / school activities, if symptom free without the use of medication. If close contacts were identified, they have been contact traced and notified. Those close contacts will not return to school, work or activities until their quarantine period expires and they are symptom free without the use of medications.
