Dear Mayfield City Schools Teachers, Staff, Parents and Community,

As we enter the second full school year in a pandemic, Mayfield Clty School leaders continue to daily review COVID-19 data as it relates to our four communities - Mayfield Heights, Mayfield Village, Gates Mills and Highland Heights. Each day, district officials examine and discuss COVID-19 case data from local health experts and zip code case data (44124, 44143, 44040) to drive our decisions, along with case counts reported on the Mayfield City Schools COVID-19 dashboard and daily attendance across the district and at our schools.

On August 17, 2021, Mayfield City Schools made the decision to require masks for all students and staff in grades Pre-K-5 and strongly recommend masks for all students and staff in grades 6-12. Wearing a face mask may greatly reduce the risk of students, teachers and staff having to quarantine if a COVID-19 positive case/s are reported in any of our Mayfield schools.

Per the Ohio Department of Health, the district will continue to notify parents, teachers and staff of positive COVID-19 cases as they are reported. Today, the district was notified of 1 positive COVID-19 case involving 1 CEVEC student from Willoughby Eastlake. In accordance with the established protocols set forth by the CCBH, the student will remain at home for 10 days and may return to school / school activities, if symptom free without the use of medication. If close contacts were identified, they have been contact traced and notified. Those close contacts will not return to school, work or activities until their quarantine period expires and they are symptom free without the use of medications.
