Mechanical Engineering Technology, Electrical Engineering Technology, or similar

Computer Science, Computer Information Systems, Management Information Systems

This is a one-time award of \$2500 for freshman year studies.

Scholarship funds are made payable to the high school/school district, which then disburses the funds via a check made payable to the recipient upon verification of college admission by the high school. Alternatively, some school districts make the funds available directly to the student's college account. Student must work with appropriate high school contact (e.g., guidance counselor/principal/district administrator) before high school graduation, to ensure disbursement of funds.
