Beginning **Monday Aug 17th**, Mayfield City Schools will provide families in need with contact-less home delivered meals (or community drop-off location).

- Families **must pre-order 48 hours in advance**, and you can order up to 5 days in advance.
- Please note Monday August 17th order must be pre-ordered by Noon August 13th.
- To Pre-Order meals, please go to the School Store within Infinite Campus to make your meal requests.
- The pre-ordered meal(s) will not be charged at the reduced price to your Food Service account until the meal is delivered.

Meals will be delivered on Monday, Tuesday (for Tuesday and Wednesday), and Thursday (for Thursday and Friday).

If home delivery is not desired due to students being at a sitter's home, meals can be picked up on delivery days (Monday's, Tuesday's and Thursday's) at Mayfield High School 6116 Wilson Mills Road by calling 995-6880 or Mayfield Middle School 1123 S.O.M. Center Road by calling 995-7831.
