## Activity Steps

1. **Introduce** the video topic to students by saying: *Today we're going to watch a video that explores how you can create a social media presence that reflects the real you.*
2. **Show** the [Teen Voices: Who Are You on Social Media?](#) video (5:13 minutes). (Note: Use the video video player to turn on subtitles in Spanish.)
3. **Lead** a class discussion exploring the questions below.

**Distance learning option:** Have students watch the video and complete the handout. If there's time, have students share their responses during a video meeting.

## Discussion Questions

1. *How do you curate your life on social media?*
  - *Answers will vary. Highlight examples that the teens in the video shared like:*
    - *only sharing certain types of pictures*
    - *only sharing posts or images related to one activity or hobby*
    - *posting content that is relevant to certain audiences (college sports scouts, specific groups of friends, etc...)*
2. *Which perspectives stood out to you in the video?*

3. *Which did you agree or disagree with? Why?*
