Activity Steps

- 1. **Introduce** the video topic to students by saying: Today we are going to watch a video that explores what type of information is and is not OK to share online.
- 2. **Show** the <u>Private and Personal Information</u> video (1:20 minutes). (Note: The video is also available in Spanish, and you can use the video player to turn on subtitles.)
- 3. **Lead** a class discussion exploring the questions below.

Distance learning option: Have students watch the video and complete the handout. If there's time, have students share their responses during a video meeting.

Discussion Questions

- **1.** What type of information about you is OK to share? Sample responses:
 - It is OK to share personal information. Personal information includes things like: what you like to do, your favorite movie, ideas that you have, or even pictures of your pet.
- **2.** What type of information isn't? Sample responses:
 - It is not OK to share private information. Private information includes things that identify you, such as your full name, home address, phone number, school, or date of birth.
- **3.** Why shouldn't you share private information? Sample responses:
 - You should not share private information because someone could use it to identify you
 individually. They could try to contact you, or use the information to impersonate you.
