As another school year comes to a close we understand this year has been especially challenging. In our continued efforts to ensure no child goes hungry, we want to make you aware of two resources:

- 1.) Pandemic Electronic Benefit Transfer (P-EBT)
- All households with children in grades K-12 who, if not for the closure of their school, would receive free or reduced-price school meals are eligible to receive this one time benefit. If you are already receiving benefits from the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) P-EBT benefits will be added to the account in which the child is active by the end of May. If you are not currently a SNAP recipient or an account cannot be matched you will receive a preloaded P-EBT card in the mail by mid-June. If you have additional questions please call 1-866-244-0071.
