- Fee for all services listed below is based off of your income – you must bring proof of income to appointment and insurance card, if you have insurance.
- Medical Services & Teen Clinic – 216.721.4010
 - Adult Primary Care Clinic
 - Monday: 9:20-5:40 pm, Tuesday-Friday 9:20-4 pm, by appointment
 - General medical services, specialty clinics, annual exams, chronic care (obesity, diabetes, high blood pressure, high cholesterol, asthma), women's health, work physicals
 - Evening Clinic
 - Monday only from 6-8 pm – same day appointment
 - STDs, Pregnancy Tests, Birth Control, Emergency Contraception
 - Walk-in Clinics
 - 2nd and 4th Saturdays – doors open at 8:30 am – no appointments needed
 - Acute care only – STDs, coughs, colds, sore throats, sinus symptoms, rash, pink eye, UTIs, stitch removal, pregnancy tests, work physicals, earache, ear wax removal
 - Teen Clinic (Ages 13-21+)
 - Monday and Tuesdays: Walk-ins are welcome at 1:30 pm and appointments on Thursdays
 - General medical services; education, prevention, and testing for HIV and STDs; women's health; family planning services and counseling, birth control
 - Pediatric Clinic
 - Monday-Friday, appointments and walk-ins available
