

2025 GRADUATION INFORMATION

Saturday, May 31st, 2025

Time:

2:00 p.m. Connor Palace Theatre, doors open at 1:00 p.m.

All participants and guests must exit the theatre by 4:00 p.m.

Graduating seniors must arrive no later than 1:15 p.m. wearing their caps and gowns. The cap and gown is your admission into the theatre. Graduating seniors do not need a ticket to enter the theatre. Please note there is no secure place to leave purses or other personal belongings in the theatre. All personal belongings should be left with family members. No children age two or under will be admitted. Also, balloon and noisemakers are prohibited.

<u>Parking</u>: Cost is approximately \$20. Playhouse Square has a garage behind the theatre with a connecting walkway to the theaters. Prepaid parking is available at Playhouse Square Parking Garage (this will be available a few weeks prior to the graduation date). <u>Please be sure to pick the correct date and time frame for the ceremony</u>.

Cap & Gown Tradition:

The high school cap and gown symbolize scholarship and learning, therefore, they should be placed on the head with the deep part to the back. It should first be placed well down over the forehead, and then pulled down firmly at the back. It should not be worn in a tilted position.

No writing or decorations will be permitted on the caps or gown.

The gown is not designed to take the place of ordinary wearing apparel. Dress code is: Light-colored dresses, pantsuits or white shirts, with ties and dress slacks underneath the gown. The cap and gown are yours to keep. Congratulations to all the graduates! Remember to be proud of your accomplishments and your school.

<u>Special Reminders</u>: Seniors who violate our student code of conduct or who participate in acts of vandalism or pranks will be suspended from school and may lose their privileges to attend the commencement program. We expect our seniors to act like adults and behave like good citizens.

- 1- Any writing on cars must be in good taste. Any pornographic or offensive in nature will be handled in a disciplinary manner.
 - 2- All seniors are advised not to visit other schools.
- 3- All seniors are reminded to drive slowly and carefully to avoid accidents.
- 4- <u>Destruction or vandalizing of other's property will not be condoned</u>. Any behavior of this type inflicted on the community will be immediately referred to the police.
- 5- Motorcades or car caravans are <u>not</u> authorized by the school. Students should be discouraged from participating in any of these kinds of activities due to the dangerous driving situations that can occur.



PROM 2025

Hey Juniors and Seniors!

The end of the year is near, and there's no better time to celebrate than Prom! The Junior Class officers formally invite you to attend and experience, "A Night at the Casino."



All Students MUST arrive by 7:30 PM. Doors will be locked and no entry will be permitted after 7:30 PM.

Tickets will be on sale April 14th - May 2nd. NO TICKETS WILL BE SOLD AFTER MAY 2nd!!! Tickets MUST be purchased through the school store in Infinite Campus (credit card only, cash or checks will not be accepted). To purchase tickets, please follow the process below.

***IMPORTANT NOTE: ALL FEES MUST BE PAID prior to purchasing a ticket. Infininte Campus will block anyone from purchasing a ticket until your fees have been paid. Once your fees have been paid, the system will update within an hour and make tickets available to your account.

- Step 1: Go to the school store in Infinite Campus and click on Mayfield High school, then click 2025 Prom.
- Step 2: Purchase your ticket by choosing the option below. The buffet will include fresh greens salad, assorted deli salads, veggies and cheeses, a ham and turkey carving station, chicken, salmon, scalloped potatoes, sweet corn, penne marinara, and assorted desserts. All tickets are individual tickets; there are no "couple" tickets. All Mayfield students should select ONE "Mayfield Student Buffet" ticket and add this to your cart. If you are purchasing another ticket for a guest, finish your ticket order and then move to step 3 below.
 - \$100.00 Mayfield Student Buffet
- Step 3: If you are purchasing a ticket for a guest, go back in and purchase another ticket. From the "options" list, choose one of the guest tickets below. Make sure that your name appears as "recipient". YOU MUST then enter the name of your guest in the "comments" section. REMEMBER, if you are bringing a guest from another school, the Guest Permission Slip Form must be completed and signed by an administrator PRIOR to purchasing your ticket. The permission slip form is attached to this email, and hard copies can be found in the Student Affairs office. The form must be submitted to Mrs. Wetzel in the Student Affair office ASAP, but no later than APRIL 30th.
 - \$100.00 Guest Mayfield (Buffet)
 - \$100.00 Guest Non-Mayfield (Buffet)
- Step 4: After you have purchased your ticket(s), you **MUST** choose your seat for dinner. During all lunch periods, the junior class officers will be at a table outside of the cafeteria making seat assignments. Make sure you bring your ticket confirmation. This will be your assigned seat for dinner, and **changes CANNOT** be made. Those students who do not go to choose their seat(s) after purchasing their ticket(s) will be assigned to what is left over after ticket sales are closed.

Dear Junior and Senior Parents and Guardians:

1. Who is eligible to attend After Prom?

2. How are tickets to After Prom purchased?

a. The \$30 per person ticket will be available for purchase on the Cheddar Up website starting April 14, 2025. A parent/guardian phone number is required when purchasing tickets. Tickets are non-transferable and non-refundable. NO TICKETS WILL BE SOLD AT THE DOOR

3. What does the ticket entitle your child?

a. All activities, food, prizes and much more. Grand Prize drawing held at 2:00 am and your child must be present to win.

Rules for After Prom 2025

- 1. TICKETS ARE NOT AVAILABLE AT THE DOOR, MUST BE PURCHASED IN ADVANCE. Tickets are non-transferable and non-refundable.
- 2. Check-In will begin at Mayfield Heights Community Center at 11:30 p.m. Students will need to arrive on their own to the community center. No busing will be provided.
- 3. A parent/guardian will be notified if students do not arrive at the community center by 12:00 a.m. AND students will remain at Mayfield Heights Community Center until 2:00 a.m. unless a parent comes and picks them up early. The parent needs to come in the building and sign your child out.
- 4. All attendees, including non-Mayfield students, must adhere to the Student Code of Conduct as described in the Mayfield High School Handbook, the laws of the State of Ohio and Mayfield After Prom Rules.
- 5. Students must be present to win the Raffle prizes.
- 6. Wear casual, comfortable, and appropriate clothing.
- 7. Security personnel and first aid staff will be on hand to insure the health and safety of all guests.
- 8. All activities at the After Prom are free. There is no need for money. Please leave purses, backpacks, etc at home. This will alleviate any possibility of something being misplaced or stolen.
- 9. Parents/guardians will be called and expected to immediately pick up their child if the child arrives under the influence.
- 10. No drinks of any kind are allowed into the party. **DO NOT** bring water, pop, or Gatorade bottles to this event.
- 11. Students will be leaving the event at 2:00 a.m.
- 12. Most Importantly, have a great time at After Prom!!!!!!

Senior picnic - After the elementary bus tour., enjoy a picnic in courtyard.

<u>Senior banquet</u> – 6-11 p.m. at Pine Ridge Country Club Ballroom. Cost is \$60, which will include dinner, dessert, dancing, and awarding of the Senior Superlatives. DO NOT bring your cap and gown. ALL SENIORS GRADUATING WITH THE CLASS OF 2025 MUST BE PRESENT! YOU MUST RIDE THE BUS TO AND FROM REHEARSAL, AND YOU MUST BE ON TIME! SENIORS WHO DO NOT ATTEND REHEARSAL WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE GRADUATION CEREMONY ON SATURDAY. Please note you do not need to dress up for rehearsal. Wear your normal school attire.

Graduation at Connor Palace Theatre 2:00 p.m.

Doors open for public seating at 1:00 p.m. All graduating seniors should plan to arrive at Connor Palace Theatre by 1:15 p.m. A professional photographer will take a picture of each student receiving her/his diploma. Purchase of the picture will be the individual's option. (Please see flier from MK Photography posted on the high school senior info website). The graduation ceremony will be streamed live. The link will be on the high school web page that day, and will remain posted for a while for downloading or burning your own DVD.

WE ASK THAT FRIENDS AND FAMILY NOT TAKE PICTURES DURING THE GRADUATION CEREMONY EXCEPT FROM YOUR SEAT. NO ONE WILL BE PERMITTED TO STAND IN THE AISLE TO TAKE PHOTOGRAPHS OR VIDEO RECORDINGS.
