Date: Saturday, June 1st, 2024

Time: 2:00 p.m. Connor Palace Theatre, doors will open at 1:00 p.m.

All participants and guests must exit the theatre by 4:00 p.m.

Graduating seniors must arrive no later than 1:15 p.m. wearing their caps and gowns. The cap and gown is your admission into the theater. Graduating seniors do not need a ticket to enter the theatre. Please note there is no secure place to leave purses, cameras or phones in the theatre. All personal belongings should be left with family members. No children age two or under will be admitted. Also balloons and noisemakers are prohibited.

LOCATION: Connor Palace Theatre, Playhouse Square Center

Admission by ticket only. Assigned seating.

PARKING: Cost is approximately \$20. The following parking areas close to Playhouse Square are available:

- a) Playhouse Square parking garage, East 15th St. & Chester Ave.
- b) Lumen Garage-Enter 17th St
- c) US Bank Garage, 2060 E 14th St
- d) Hanna Garage, 1509 Prospect Ave
- e) Three parking lots on Chester Ave. between 13th & 17th Streets

Detailed maps can be found online, use Playhouse Square Parking as your search. You can also purchase parking prior to graduation on this site. **Be sure to pick the correct location, date and time.**

Cap & Gown Tradition:

The high school cap and gown symbolize scholarship and learning, therefore, they should be worn with dignity. The cap should be placed on the head with the deep part to the back. It should first be placed well down over the forehead, and then pulled down firmly at the back. It should not be worn in a tilted position.

No writing will be permitted on the caps or gowns.

The gown is not designed to take the place of ordinary wearing apparel. Girls wear light-colored dresses or pantsuits, and boys wear white shirts and ties with dress slacks underneath their gowns. The cap and gown is yours to keep. Congratulations to all graduates! Remember to be proud of your accomplishments and your school.

Special Reminders: Seniors who violate our student conduct code or who participate in acts of vandalism or trickery will be suspended from school and may lose their privileges to attend the commencement program. We expect our seniors to act like adults and behave like good citizens.

1. Any writing on cars must be in good taste. Anything pornographic or offensive in nature will be handled in a disciplinary manner.
2. All seniors are advised not to visit other schools.
3. All seniors are reminded to drive slowly and carefully to avoid accidents.
4. Destruction or vandalizing of other's property will not be condoned. Any behavior of this type inflicted on the community will be immediately referred to the police.
5. Motorcades or car caravans are not authorized by the school. Students should be discouraged from participating in any of these kinds of activities due to the dangerous driving situations, which usually result.

MAYFIELD HIGH SCHOOL JUNIOR/SENIOR PROM 2024

On Saturday, May 18, 2024, the Junior/Senior Prom will be held at Signature of Solon Country Club. In order to inform parents of the activities and guidelines pertaining to this special event and to help promote a safe and enjoyable evening, we are providing you with the following information:

WHEN: Saturday, May 18, 2024 from 6:00 pm – 11:00 pm

WHERE: 39000 Signature Dr., Solon, 44139

COST: \$100.00 per person (\$110.00 if choosing the steak entree). All tickets are purchase individually, there are no “couple” tickets. All tickets will be sold online through the school store in Infinite Campus (<https://mayfieldschools.infinitecampus.org/campus/store/mayfield/home>). Specific information about purchasing tickets and choosing seat assignments will be sent to students’ emails. Tickets will be on sale from April 22th to May 10th.

*****All student fees must be paid prior to the purchase of any ticket.**

*****No tickets will be sold after May 10th!!!**

*****If you take a guest from another school, a guest permission slip must be turned-in ASAP. No permission slips will be accepted after May 8!**
(Guest forms will be emailed to all students, but they can also be found in the school store and in the Student Affairs office).

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- a. Doors will open at 5:45 pm (**no earlier**).
- b. Crowning of the Prom King and Queen will follow dinner.
- c. If you are taking a date from another school, you **MUST** have your guest permission slip approved by an administrator. Guests must follow all Mayfield rules, regardless of their ages.
- d. Students entering the Prom will have their names checked for accountability purposes and will not be permitted to leave and return. Students must arrive by 7:30pm (no entry will be permitted after this time). Once students leave the Prom, they will not be allowed to re-enter, and it is assumed that a parent will know of his or her child’s whereabouts; School chaperones cannot be responsible for students after they leave the Prom.
- e. Parents are encouraged to discuss safety and proper behavior for this occasion with their son(s) or daughter(s).
- f. Students under the influence of alcohol or any other chemical substance will not be permitted to enter the Prom. They will be suspended from school and may suffer other additional consequences, including forfeiting the privilege of attending commencement.
- g. Parents are expected to **not serve alcoholic beverages** of any kind prior to or after the Prom. Student safety is of the utmost importance. Remember, the legal drinking age in Ohio is 21 for any alcoholic beverages, and the state law specifies that any driver under 21 years of age who tests as low as .01 on a breathalyzer will be charged with a DUI.
- h. Students are expected to dress in proper attire throughout the entire prom.

Wear your normal school attire.

Seats will be selected by the graduate/graduate's family (the same process as attending a production at the theatre).
