Vocabulary

3. **Event**

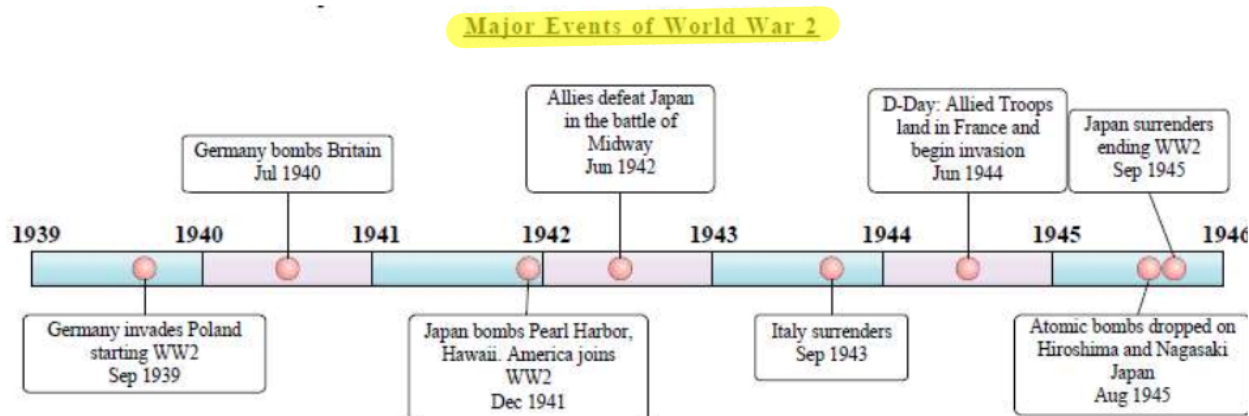
