Dear Mayfield Families,

Over the course of a student's high school career, they are mandated by the State of Ohio to test in the areas of English Language Arts 1 & 2, Biology, US History, Mathematics 1 & 2, and Government. Students that are currently enrolled in any of these courses will test in the spring and accumulate points which will help them meet their graduation pathway. Please note that upperclassmen enrolled in US Government already took their end of course exams in the fall and will not need to test during this administration.

Although testing can be disruptive, we have created a schedule which will allow our tested students the ability to attend all of their classes daily. In order to accomplish this goal, a late-start schedule has been created. We have included the late start dates, exams, and schedule on the following page for your review.

Mayfield High School will be running a delayed-start schedule on **April 16, 17, 23, 24, 30, and May 1**. It is imperative that students in tested subjects arrive on time for their end of course exams. Testing will begin promptly at 7:45 AM on each of the aforementioned dates. On these dates our busses will run at their normal scheduled time. Therefore, if students do not have alternative transportation, they may report to school at the normal time and either seek out a teacher for assistance or work in a supervised collaborative space until their first period class. Students that are not testing and have alternative means of transportation do not have to come to school until their 1st period class. However, once students report to school they must remain in a supervised area until they are dismissed to attend first period.
