American College Test (ACT)

Given at Mayfield High School Saturday---September 14, 2019 Registration Deadline - August 16th **Please add your colleges NOW = FREE reporting** Will have to pay later.

Other Entrance Exams

- Two-Year Colleges
- COMPASS or ACCUPLACER Test
- Free admission test
- Student does not need to take ACT or SAT for two year schools or the military
- ASVAB Military test

What is Naviance?

- Web-based resource hub specific to Mayfield High School that supports student career and college planning
- Used by the Mayfield staff to communicate with students, parents, and colleges
- Processes **ALL** college application materials

The Application Process

• Begin with Naviance

"Colleges I'm interested in" to "Colleges I'm applying to"

• What type of application is required?

- Common Application or Online Application via individual school site
- If there is a choice between Common App and the school's application, you ****MUST**** use Common App.

Common App, WHAT?!?

If there is a choice between Common App and the college's application, you ****MUST**** use Common App.

ONLY, use the college's application if they are **NOT** associated with the Common App.

The Application Process

Using Common App

*Reminder: If you are applying to a Common App school, you MUST use the Common App!!

- Go to <u>www.commonapp.org</u>
- Set up your personal account/login.
- Complete a profile, add colleges, complete the application, upload essay, etc.
- Check to see if your colleges require supplements and/or fees and complete those.
- PROOFREAD all items before you submit.
- Be aware that once you hit 'submit' you will not be able to make changes to your application.

<u>Using the Online Application on</u> <u>the College Website</u>

- To apply online go to that particular college's website and follow directions to apply.
 - Complete the application, upload essay, etc.
 - Check for and pay fees.
 - PROOFREAD all items before you submit.

<u>Complete & send each</u> <u>application at least 2 weeks</u> <u>before any deadline.</u>

Letters of Recommendation

Mayfield teachers LOR

Please ask teachers at least one month in advance from deadline.

Please advise teachers to upload their letters to Naviance. We will not upload for them.

Non-Mayfield LORs

Please have LOR dropped off to counseling dept or emailed to your counselor to upload in Naviance.

Counselor LORs

As needed Please review each college application & requirements. Please allow at least two weeks notice before deadlines.

College Campus Visitations

 Two days of excused absences are allowed per student handbook

PROCEDURE

- Note from parent giving date and name of college/s to be visited given to Mrs. Spiccia at least 24 hours in advance
- Student has teachers sign form from Mrs. Spiccia and then returns form to her at the end of the day

Admissions Representatives

- Representatives from colleges visit Mayfield to meet with interested students
- List of representatives on Naviance, sent to students in their MHS emails, and also on the morning announcements.
- You **MUST** register for a college rep visit through Naviance.
- Forget to register? Get a pass from your teacher in order to attend otherwise you will be marked absent/class cut.

After You Apply

• Logging in: Naviance

- Colleges I'm Applying To → "Have you applied?" → Find College → "I Have Submitted My Application"
- Check "Submission Type."
- Match your Naviance account to your CommonApp.
- Request transcript through Naviance
 - Colleges I'm Applying To → Request Transcripts/Manage Transcripts → "What type of transcript are you requesting?"→ Initial
- Mid-Year Reports (January)
- Final Transcripts (June)
- Start Financial Aid/Scholarships on October 1st
