Dear Mayfield teachers, staff, students, parents and community

I hope this communication finds you well. I indicated in my November 27, 2020 letter that I would make a decision on December 4th as to resuming the in-person learning option at Millridge Elementary and Mayfield High School.

<u>Millridge Elementary</u> will resume in-person learning for those families who choose to do so on Monday, December 7th. If your student was previously in-person and you are opting to stay remote, please notify your principal. <u>New COVID-19</u> cases come in daily resulting in further quarantines that may warrant a reversal to full remote learning at any time. Please be prepared for this possibility.

It is important to note that COVID has impacted our transportation department just as some non-public schools (we are required by law to transport these students as well) return to in-person learning. We are working on solutions. Please anticipate the times for bus pick up / drop off may be delayed up to 25 minutes. We ask for your patience and understanding as we work through this problem.

<u>Mayfield High School</u> will remain on a full remote learning plan until at least January 4th, due to staffing issues related COVID-19 quarantines. My hope is to be able to provide an in-person option at MHS when we begin the new semester on January 4th.

We continue to assess the impact of COVID-19 on our ability to provide an in-person learning option to the 66.6% of our students and their families who prefer it. Our choices in and out of school play a critical role in our ability to provide the in-person learning option in each of our schools and programs.

As you know, our staff continues to do an amazing job making adjustments and refining creative techniques to provide the best instruction they can. Please continue to send them emails of encouragement and thanks. It makes a big difference.
