## **East India Company**

- Trading rights since 1600's
- Governed India for Britain
- Main goal = make money
- By 1800, converted Indians to Christianity, introduced western education and legal procedures, attempted social reform

#### **Causes of Discontent**

- Disregarded Indian culture
  - o Passed law allowing Hindu widows to remarry
  - o Required Sepoys, Indian soldiers, to serve anywhere
    - Overseas travel was an offense to Hindus
  - o Issued rifles to Sepoys, tips of cartridges needed bit off
  - o Greased w/ animal fat
    - Pig = forbidden to Muslims
    - Cow = sacred to Hindus

## Sepoy Rebellion (1857)

- Sepoys (Indian soldiers) brutally massacred British men, women and children across northern and central India
- British crushed revolt
- Parliament ended rule of the British East India Company, India came under British rule (1858)
  - Direct Rule (Viceroy)

### **British Colonial Rule**

- Britain saw India as a market and source of raw materials
- Flooded India w/ cheap, machine-made textiles, ruining the hand-weaving industry in India
- Massive deforestation (cutting down trees)
- Pushed farmers to grow cash crops (cotton, jute, opium)
- Medical Improvements & new farming methods led to rapid population growth; causing famine
- Expected Indians to copy their manners, customs, and beliefs
  - Did not expect to adopt any Indian traditions or beliefs themselves

# **Benefits to Colonial Rule**

- Revised legal system to promote justice regardless of class/caste
- Built roads and large railroad network
- Telegraph
- Postal system
- Western Education for Upper classes
