

Pool Rules

General

- Obey Lifeguards at all times
- Wildcat Sport & Fitness Staff reserves the right to make all decisions within the pool area
- Swimmers with known medical conditions are encouraged to wear medical I.D. tags and to inform the lifeguard on duty
- Adults (18 and over) are permitted to use snorkels with prior Lifeguard approval and skills test
- No scuba equipment
- Youth 12 and under must be supervised at all times by an adult (18 and over) from pool deck
- Youth 7 and under must have an adult in the water with them at all times
- Beverages must contain a lid – No glass on the pool deck
- No diaper changing on the pool deck
- No foul or inappropriate language or behavior
- Swimmers must wear swim suits; A t-shirt may be worn with a swim suit underneath – No street clothes
- Street shoes are not permitted on the pool deck
- The pool will close 30 minutes prior to the building closing. Please plan to be out of the building by closing time
- “Wet” persons are to remain in designated “wet areas”
- Balcony area is reserved for spectators of program participants – No loitering
- Use of cell phones is prohibited in locker rooms

Lap Lane Etiquette

- Youth 17 and under are required to pass a swim test to use lap lanes
- During open swim, Lane 1 (closest to diving well) may be designated for Family and Youth swimming

Deep Water Test

- Without the ladder a child must successfully enter the deep water feet first, recover to the surface, and maintain position by treading water for 1 minute. Level off and swim front crawl 25 yards. To be successful, child cannot touch the wall or ground and must be horizontal during front crawl
- Child names will be recorded in book upon passing the Deep Water Test
- Children who do not pass the test will not be allowed to swim past the blue buoys without an adult in the water with them

Pool Parties

- Obey Lifeguards at all times
- Pool rules are posted and printed and strictly enforced; Lifeguards reserve the right to prohibit any actions or behavior deemed dangerous
- Lifeguards may restrict participants from the diving well or deep water based on participant’s swimming ability, regardless of age
- One adult must be designated to act as the liaison to the Aquatic Staff
- Direct supervision of children by the adults must be maintained at all times while children are in the pool
- Supervision is defined as being able to see/hear/discipline the children that adult is directly responsible for watching
- The adult liaison must inform the Aquatic Staff of any medical conditions that may exist with any of their group prior to entering the pool
- The Wildcat Staff members on duty are in charge at all times, and the adults accompanying their group are expected to support the staff in the enforcement of all rules and regulations

Thunder and Lightning Policy

WSF patrons/simmers will be cleared from the water and pool deck, the pool will remain closed for 15 minutes following the most recent lightning or thunder.

Fire Alarm Policy

When the fire alarm is activated **ALL** persons in the facility, including the swimmers must exit the facility. Please do not go into the locker rooms. Follow the directions of staff members.

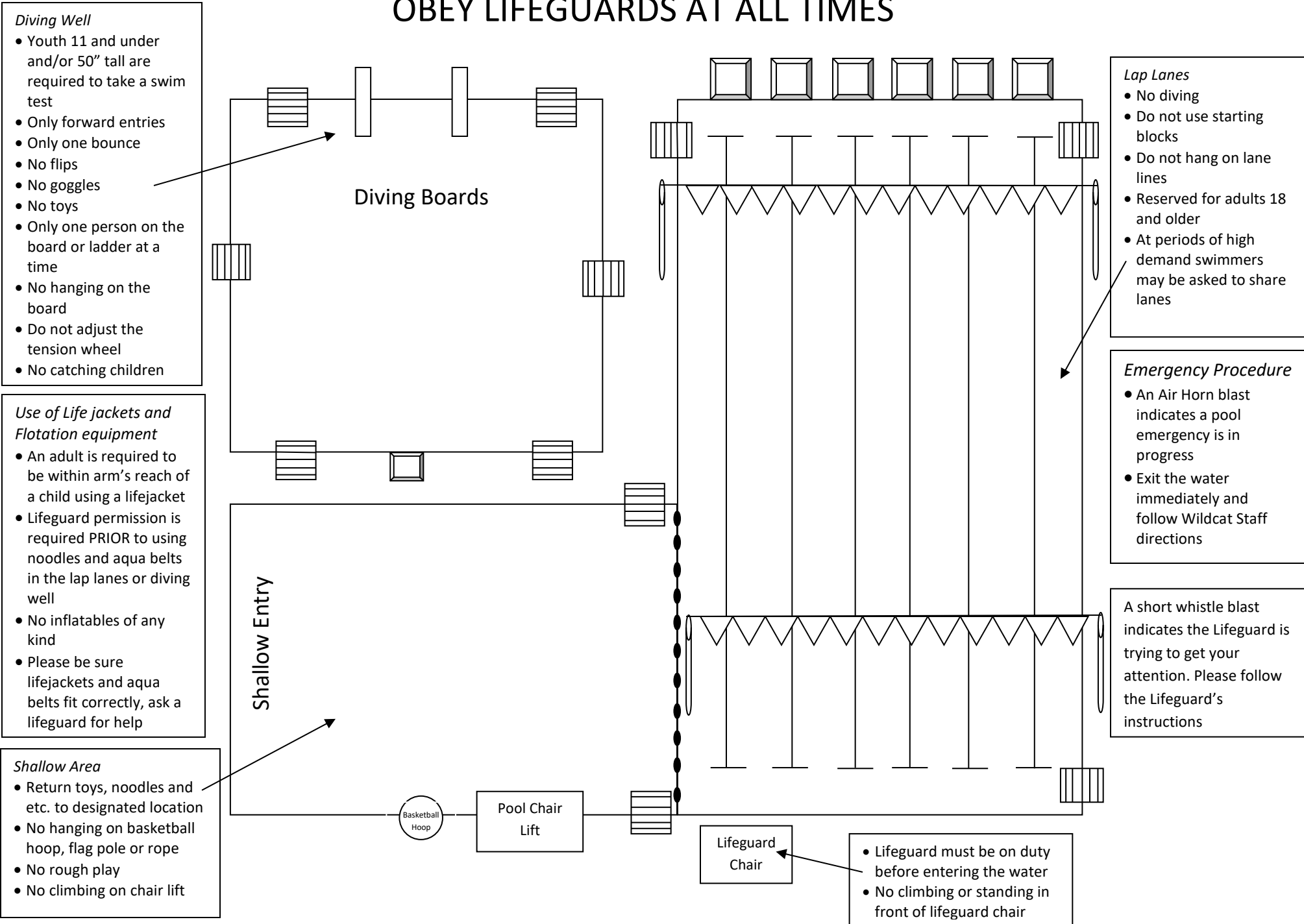
