Please provide the following information if your child has a G-tube button whether they will be receiving feedings at school or not.

- Physician's orders which describe the care the child needs during school hours.
 - 1. Physician's order can state "G-tube feeding as directed by parent"
 - 2. G-tube site care?
 - 3. Will there be oral feedings or nothing by mouth?
 - 4. Emergency instructions in the event that the tube becomes dislodged.
- If your child will be receiving tube feedings or medications via the G-tube, we will need the following items:
 - Medication orders-completed by the physician and parent if the student needs any
 medications through the G-tube or applied to the site. This is needed for prescribed
 medications or over-the-counter medications. Medication forms can be accessed on
 the Mayfield website under the Parents section.
 - Syringes if medication is to be given via the G-tube.
 - o **Infusion pump** with rechargeable battery and charger.
 - o **A pole** to hang the feeding bag on and to attach the pump to.
 - o **A supply of bags**. We would like to have 2 weeks' supply on hand.
 - o Formula in individual serving size.
 - Mic-Key tube-a packaged spare to be kept in school. In addition, a new one sent in each
 week which we will send home at the end of the week or dispose of if that is your
 choice.
 - Food and supplies if there are to be oral feedings.
 - Parent instructions:
 - Name of formula
 - Amount of formula per feeding
 - Length of time the feeding should take
 - Will there be a water flush following the feed and if so, how much?
 - Any care for the g-tube site
 - Mic-Key send home at the end of the week or dispose (circle one)
 - Notify Health Services of any changes in medical condition, medications, feedings, etc.
